Upcoming Special Events:

<u>Special Presentation</u> - A check for \$1,480.00 was presented to Michelle Spicer as being the sole "hole-in-one" winner on a Tellico Course this past season. This was achieved on Tanasi, Hole #8, using 6-hybrid and June 11, 2018. (Effective today, April 2, 2019, the Hole-in-One Club runs thru the day prior to the banquet next Spring.)

Give Back Day, Barbara Jones (Ch.) assisted by Pam Skinner, Bonnie Porcello and Barb Lindner - Barbara spoke of the charity "Newborns in Need", of the many different items (such as diapers, blankets, bottles, sleepers, toiletries, etc.) that can be used to benefit these babies being born with none of the basic necessities. This event will be held May 7th at Toqua. She provided a list of the needed items. (Already, Donnie Iverson gave a generous donation of \$250 and Michelle Spicer made a contribution from her hole-in-one winnings.)

<u>League Championship</u>, August 27 & 28 at Tanasi and Toqua. Member must have at least 7 rounds of golf in the league to be eligible.

Member-Member, Laura Imboden (Ch.) - will be a 1-day Par 3 event on Aug 13th at Kahite - additional information will be distributed as further plans are made.

Directories with members' information and schedule will be distributed within next couple weeks.

On <u>Pin Day</u> this year, we will have low putt winners for both flights rather than one overall winner. The Board would appreciate any feedback after the first month as to whether members like this change. Also, on PIN Day, if there should be only 6 players in a flight, only 2 places will be awarded to that flight. The more players a flight has, then more places may be awarded. The league schedule is set to try and have 2 Pin Days at each of the courses, but not consecutively.

On <u>Team Game Days</u> (in April) we will add an OVERALL low net and low gross along with the team winners (similar to the Medalist Award as done by Knox Area Women's Assn.). Feedback at the end of April will be solicited. If this type of play is done throughout the year, there will be a year-end award for both yellow and green medalist.

Members will <u>record birdies</u> as in the past on the scorecard with person's name and Hole #. However, this only needs to be done for a member's FIRST birdie. Consecutive birdies will not be tracked as in the past.

<u>Fall Luncheon</u> will be October 8th. As many members begin to leave for their winter retreats, the luncheon is being held earlier than usual. However, league play and points earned will continue until the end of October.

<u>Skins</u> - As started at the end of last year, skins will continue to be \$2 and will automatically include a member in low net and low gross.

In setting the schedule for various weekly games, Toqua is used for mostly individual stroke games due to the largest differential between tees.

<u>Tellico's Beautification Tournament</u>, or "Superintendent's Revenge", is being held Saturday, April 13th at Toqua. Kristin Farrington is a member of the Golf Advisory Committee and announced it is the 12th year for this event and approximately 75 have signed up so far. A person can sign up at any of the courses. She also asked members for any craft-like or homemade and quilted items as their will be door prizes and a select auction. She also asked for key-lime pies to be made or donated to this event.
